Among them is a considerable number of species which cause harm in agriculture and forestry. The book can serve as a reference source for the identification of rust fungi and for measures to combat them. Investigations on rust fungi were begun in 1938 by V. G. Tranzschel, while his well-known Obzor rzhavchinnyykh gribov SSSR (Conspectus Uredinalium URSS) was still being printed. The publication of this work facilitated preparation of the present book. According to the plan proposed by V. G. Tranzschel, description of the rust fungi included a sufficiently detailed description of species, references to pertinent literature, synonyms, data on biological properties, and a list of host plants with indication of their distribution according to regions corresponding to those listed in Flora of the USSR, published by the Institute of Botany of AN SSSR [the Academy of Sciences of the USSR], or a catalog listing major locations.
