

My reasons for this action are embodied in the pardon, and are as follows: He was convicted upon wholly circumstantial evidence as is shown by the following statement, which is a fair outline of the evidence in the case: That on the 15th day of September, A. D. 1809, one John Willits was murdered in the bedroom of his house in the city of...
